Application Fee	Date application is filled out.
Deposit	Within 14 days of the acceptance email. Or immediately, if accepted after August 28 th .
Remaining Tuition Balance	Due the first day of class or may be broken into two payments, with second half being due the last Sunday of October.

STEPS TO APPLY

1. Apply at aussm.org (1st, 2nd Year and Alumni applications are available online).
2. Pay \$35 application fee online or by check (non-refundable and is not included in cost of tuition).
3. Send Pastoral and Personal Recommendation links to those who will be recommending you. After applying, you will receive the links via email. Please forward the links to those whom you want to recommend. Once they fill it out, the office receives it digitally. (Please note: This step is only applicable to First Year Students).
4. Interview: We will schedule an appointment to connect with you and discuss any further questions regarding your application.
5. After your application and recommendations have been submitted and reviewed, and your interview is completed, you will receive an acceptance letter (if approved) via email.
6. A \$100 per person deposit is required, within 14 days of receiving the acceptance letter. Tuition is \$650/person or \$1250/married couple. The balance of tuition is due the first day of class. See below for three payment options:
 - A. Full tuition is paid within 14 days of acceptance to AuSSM
 - B. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 (\$200 for married couples) is due within 14 days of acceptance and applied directly to tuition. Balance is due the first day of class.
 - C. A non-refundable deposit of \$100 (\$200 for married couples) is due within 14 days of acceptance into AuSSM and is applied directly toward tuition. Half of the remaining is paid on the first day of class and the balance is due the last Sunday in October.

CLASS TIME AND LOCATION

AuSSM is a nine-month school of ministry, which begins on the first Sunday after Labor Day. Graduation is on the third Sunday of May. Class takes place at True Life in Round Rock, TX on Sunday evenings from 5pm-9pm. During class, there will be a time of worship, testimonies, teaching, and activation.

REVIVAL GROUP

Revival groups meet twice a month on a Wednesday or Thursday evening from 7:00pm-8:30pm. Revival Groups are where you can share, discuss what you have been learning, and develop friendships in a small group setting. The purpose of Revival Groups is to maintain an atmosphere of intimacy, where AuSSM will remain “small”, even as it grows larger in numbers. The goal is to create a culture of connection and activation, with a hands-on approach to personal revival. Revival Groups provide a time of testimony, prayer, and ministry to each other. This is a fluid and interactive time, dependent on the leading of the Holy Spirit. The groups range between 10 and 20 students.

Examples of what the Revival Group time could include:

- A. Testimonies
- B. Activation
- C. Connection with other students and leaders
- D. Processing in-class work

All Students will be sent a survey via email, after the first day of class, where you can request either Wednesday or Thursday as your preference for Revival Group.

TREASURE HUNTS

Evangelism is an important part of AuSSM, we believe what is poured into our students must be then poured out or we become stagnant. Through treasure hunts we give students opportunities to step out together and take risks that bless and encourage our community. 3 out of the 6 Treasure hunts provided are mandatory.

SERVICE

The heart of AuSSM is that we would be known for our service. We ask that as a ministry student that you are in some capacity serving your local church. Quarterly evaluation sheets from your ministry leader will be due on the Homework deadline.

LIVE SPEAKERS

CURRICULUM

AuSSM uses Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry's lesson curriculum in class and online through BSSM Equip.

Our First Year program lays a strong foundation of identity, which is then built upon with more kingdom teaching and revelation.

Our Second Year Program goes deeper into prophecy and activating the gifts within you.

Through the BSSM curriculum, you will hear from speakers such as Bill Johnson, Kris Vallotton, Danny Silk, and Beni Johnson. You will learn about identity, prophecy, prayer, honor, and much more.

HOMEWORK

Class Homework is assigned through Bethel Equip online, you will be assigned an account and weekly coursework. Each course assigned will be watched in class or at home. as a group the previous Sunday, you will be responsible for answering the Review Questions (4-7 questions) that are assigned with each lesson. Once a month we will have Activation Night and a coursework will be assigned to watch. Grades are Pass/Fail. Bethel Equip allows student access lessons (as well as an audio version) for review/absences, downloadable notes and much more.

BSSM Equip-Accessing this curriculum requires you to own a computer and have access to the internet
